Septums?

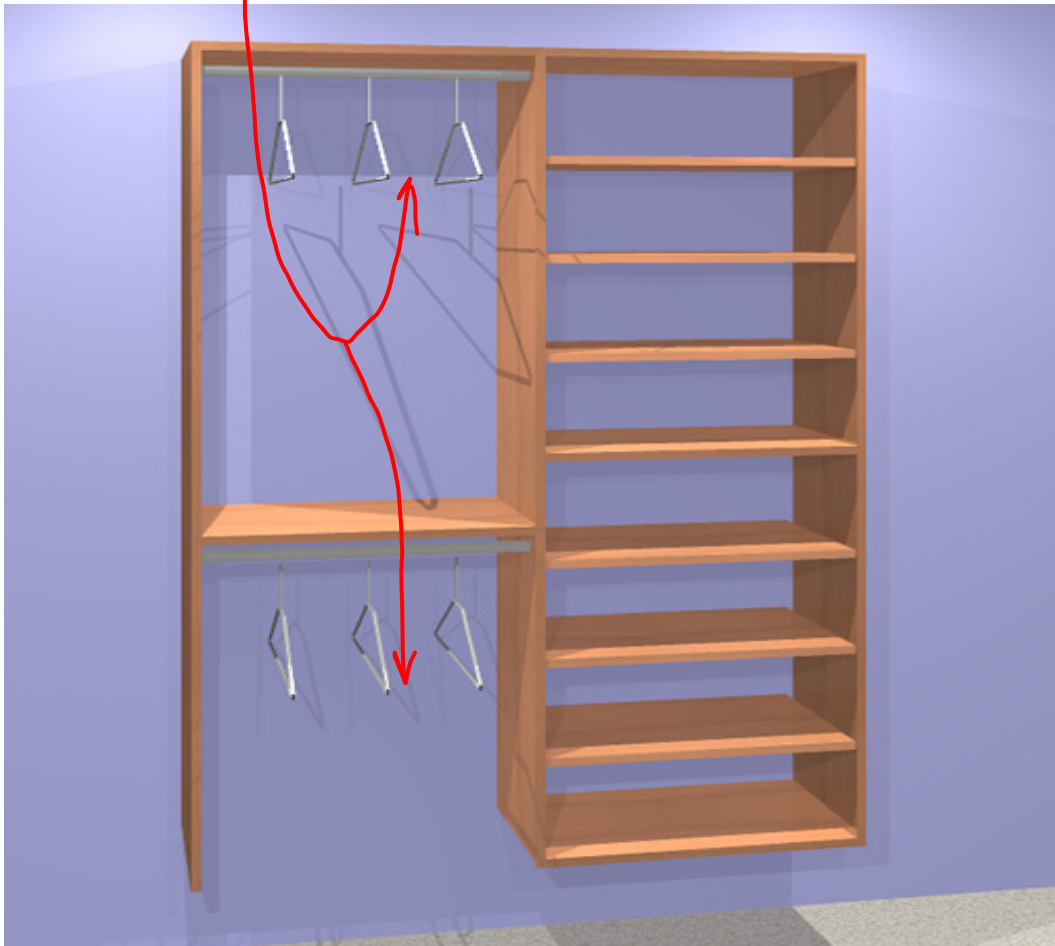
Septums are the vertical pieces of wood that go from top to bottom used primarily as the wall hanging support that depicts the height of the closet system.





Double Hang Units?

Double hang units are a section of the closet system that optimizes your hanging clothes in the closet space. Say you have a closet space of 48" wide and have 1 shelf and 1 pole in it right now, by using the 4ft double hang / shelf unit that we offer we took the 48" of hanging space and combined it into 24" of space leaving you with a 24" wide shelving unit for other items you may or may not already had in your closet.





All Shelf Units?

All shelf units are a great Closet optimizing tool. The units are made up of flat adjustable shelving that can be adjusted in 1" increments as you made need to over time as you acquire more items to stow in your new closet system.
